Board Elections

The Board shall consist of five members who will each serve terms of four years. Members shall be elected by vote of the citizens of the district, except when appointed as according to law. Members elected to zone positions must reside in the zone that they represent. Members elected to at-large positions may live anywhere within the district.

Board members' positions and their respective successors in office will be designated by numbers as Zone No. 1, No. 2, No. 3, and At-Large No. 1 and At Large No. 2. In all proceedings for the nomination or election of candidates for or to the office of Board member, every petition for nomination, declaration of candidacy, certificate of nomination, ballot or other document used in connection with the nomination or election will state the position number to which the candidate aspires.

Individuals may seek more than one elected position such as school board and education service district board. However, individuals may not seek more than one elected position in the same election.

Re-elections for Board positions will occur as follows:

Zone No. 1:	Spring 2009, and every four years thereafter
Zone No. 2:	Spring 2009, and every four years thereafter
Zone No. 3:	Spring 2011, and every four years thereafter
At-Large No.1:	Spring 2011, and every four years thereafter
At-Large No. 2:	Spring 2009, and every four years thereafter

The boundaries of the three zones will be as follows:

Zone 1

Zone 1 is defined to include the area north and east of the Willamette River and the area that is north and east of a line beginning at the intersection of the Willamette River and the Albany/Millersburg City Limits and proceeding southeasterly to Old Salem Avenue thence along the centerline of Old Salem Avenue northerly to the intersection with Albany Avenue, thence southeasterly along the centerline of Albany Avenue to the intersection of Pacific Highway (Hwy. 99) thence northeasterly along the centerline of Pacific Highway (Hwy. 99) to Knox Butte Road; thence easterly along the centerline of Knox Butte Road to the intersection of Highway 20; thence generally easterly along the centerline of Highway 20 to the eastern district boundary.

Zone 2

Zone 2 is defined as the area south of Zone 1, which is east of the centerline of Hill Street and north of the Santiam Canal and extending easterly to the eastern district boundary.

Zone 3

Zone 3 is defined as the area south of the Willamette River and west of the centerline of Hill Street and south of the Santiam Canal and east of Hill Street and extending to the southern and western district boundaries.
