Adoption and Revision of Policies

The district shall be governed by a set of written policies, as required by law. These policies, with administrative rules and regulations designed to implement them, shall be available to the staff, parents or guardians¹, citizens and to the Oregon Department of Education as requested.

The Board, in the development of these policies, shall be guided by the recommendations of its staff and shall provide an opportunity for community input during the preparation and/or subsequent reviews of these statements.

The policies may be created, revised, added to, deleted or amended at a regular or special meeting of the Board of a majority of the members, provided that the proposed changes have been presented in at least one meeting prior to Board action. Minor changes in policy language, including editing, that result in no modification of policy intent may be made at a single Board meeting through the consent agenda.

It is understood that appropriate revisions of Board policies will take place if the laws or rules upon which they are based are amended by state or federal legislative bodies or the State Board of Education.

The administration shall disseminate these policies in the community and make known to the patrons of the district that they have been developed in keeping with Oregon law. They shall be available for inspection by interested parties in the district office and in the library and office of each school in the district.

¹As used in this document, the term parent includes legal guardian or person in a parental relationship. The status and duties of a legal guardian are defined in ORS 125.005 (4) and 125.300 - 125.325. The determination of whether an individual is acting in a parental relationship, for purposes of determining residency, depends on the evaluation of the factors listed in ORS 419B.373. The determination for other purposes depends on evaluation of those factors and a power of attorney executed pursuant to ORS 109.056. For special education students, parent also includes a surrogate parent, an adult student whom rights have transferred and foster parent as defined in OAR 581-015-0005(18).
