**Disposal of District Property**

The Board may, at any time, declare district real property as surplus and authorize its disposal when such property is no longer useful to the district, unsuitable for use, too costly to repair or obsolete.

All income from selling or leasing surplus or vacant school district real property shall be deposited in the Capital Project Fund to be used in financing future capital needs of a major nature in the school district.

Other district property may, at any time, be declared surplus by the Superintendent or designee, who may authorize its disposal when such property is no longer useful to the district, is unsuitable for use, is too costly to repair or is obsolete.

If the district property was purchased with state, federal or private grant funds disposal of the property shall be made as outlined in the grant or by state or federal regulations.
