Commemorative Donations

The district will consider the acceptance of donations in honor of persons or organizations who have special significance to the students, the district or the community. A room or item may be named for the person or organization in whose honor the donation is made. A plaque may be appropriately dedicated and placed on district property in recognition of the creation of a project or establishment of a fund.

A principal may received items for his/her school in honor of a person or organization having a special significance to the students of that school, the district or the community. Items received become the property of the district. Principals must have the superintendent's approval to accept any item valued at more than \$1,000, or that modifies district property, or that may require additional maintenance cost to the district. Offers of donations will be submitted to the superintendent, together with information concerning the purpose of the gift and proposed administration of the funds, and type of commemorative, if applicable. The Board must approve commemorative donations of more than \$5,000. The superintendent may establish guidelines for the acceptance of donations
