Tobacco Use

The Board recognizes that the use of tobacco may create a health and safety hazard for both users and non-users. Therefore, tobacco use, distribution or sale in district buildings, on district property and in district vehicles by staff, students and the public is prohibited.

Tobacco use is defined as the smoking of any kind of lighted pipe, cigar, cigarette or any other smoking equipment or material or chewing or sniffing of a tobacco product.

“Tobacco use prohibited” signs will be posted in appropriate locations in all district buildings.

The Board hereby directs the superintendent to adopt the necessary rules and procedures to ensure the implementation and enforcement of this tobacco-free policy.
