DECLARATION OF INTENT

We have reviewed and understand the graduation requirements for the class of _____.
After discussing all options, we agree that the individual education program selected best meets
_____’s needs and should be employed in the pursuit of
a Personalized Career Diploma. We understand that a personalized program will not meet all graduation
requirements, and that _____ will not be
eligible for a standard high school diploma under such a plan.

A Personalized Career Diploma will be awarded after completion of 24 units in the following areas:

Academics: 8.0*

(i.e., Math, Language, Reading)

Personal Development: 5.0*

(i.e., Wellness, Family Life, Living Skills, Computers)

Vocational: 5.0-7.0*

(i.e., Vocational Technology, Business, Computers, Work Experience, etc.)

Students must complete a minimum of two of the six-eight credits in their career choice area. Students must complete a minimum of one credit (maximum of two credits) in Off-Campus Work Experience or complete a one credit internship program.

Electives: 4.0-6.0*

* An IEP, ESL or other district team may modify the above requirements to meet individual needs.

The student and parent may, at any time, initiate a return to a regular diploma program. We understand that such a change may require that the student attend high school beyond the usual 4 years (grades 9 through 12).

¹As used in this document, the term parent includes legal guardian or person in a parental relationship. The status and duties of a legal guardian are defined in ORS 125.005 (4) and 125.300 - 125.325. The determination for other purposes depends on evaluation of those factors and a power of attorney executed pursuant to ORS 109.056. For special education students, parent also includes a surrogate parent, an adult student whom rights have transferred and foster parent as defined in OAR 581-015-0005(18).
