## **Homeless Students**

Homeless students in the district will have access to the education and other services needed to ensure that an opportunity is available to meet the same academic achievement standards to which all students are held.

A liaison for students in homeless situations will be designated by the district to carry out duties as required by law.

The district will ensure that homeless students are not stigmatized nor segregated on the basis of their status as homeless. A homeless student may continue or be admitted to the student's school of origin in accordance with the student's best interest. Transportation will be provided in accordance with law.

The superintendent will develop administrative regulations to remove barriers to full access and participation to school programs by homeless students.
