Student Activities/Participation

Eligibility

Students participating in school activity programs are to maintain successful academic progress and acceptable classroom conduct. Students not meeting the standards of the class or school may be referred to the advisor, coach or administrator for appropriate action.

Students suspended from school are ineligible for participation from activities until the student has been readmitted to school.

All students must meet the eligibility requirements of the club/activity or position as established by the school administration, student body constitution or advisors of the activity with administrative approval.

Students transferring into the district are eligible for activity participation unless they have been suspended or expelled from such participation in another Oregon district within the same school year, in accordance with OSAA's policy on transfers.

Responsibilities

All students participating in school activities away from the school are expected to return from the activity with their respective groups unless arrangements have been cleared in advance with the coach or advisor and the student's parents or guardians¹. Students shall be released to their parents or guardians at any time.

Actions of students while participating in activities will conform with the rules of the school as detailed in Board policy JF/JFA, Student Rights and Responsibilities. Violations will be dealt with in the same manner as though they were in the school building.

School equipment may be available to students during sponsored activities and they are responsible for the care and safe return of such equipment as supervised by the advisor or coach in charge. School property shall not be for personal use except during school-sponsored activities.

¹As used in this document, the term parent includes legal guardian or person in a parental relationship. The status and duties of a legal guardian are defined in ORS 125.005(4) and 125.300 - 125.325. The determination of whether an individual is acting in a parental relationship, for purposes of determining residency, depends on the evaluation of the factors listed in ORS 491B.373. The determination for other purposes depends on evaluation of those factors and a power of attorney executed pursuant to ORS 109.056. For special education students, parent also includes a surrogate parent, an adult student to whom rights have transferred and foster parents as defined in OAR 581-015.0005(18).

Financial responsibility for personal items used in school activities rests with the student. Advisors and coaches may assist individual students or the group as a whole in earning the necessary funds for additional equipment or attending special events. Such money raising events must have the approval of the administration.

Practices may be held on Saturday. Practices may also be held on Sunday but are optional and require the permission of the building principal. Teams may not practice on **both** Saturday and Sunday.
