## Care of District Property by Students

It is each student's responsibility to show respect for all district property. Any student who willfully damages or defaces school property will be disciplined.

The Board declares its intent to hold students and their parents or guardians<sup>1</sup> responsible for loss or damage of district property. The amount of damage to any school property shall be determined by procedures established by the district. Grade reports, diplomas and records may be withheld for failure to make restitution for assessed damages. Notice of the district's intent will be provided annually as required by law. Records requested by another school district to determine a student's appropriate placement may not be withheld.

<sup>1</sup>As used in this policy, the term parent includes legal guardian or person in a parental relationship. The status and duties of a legal guardian are defined in ORS 125.005 (4) and 125.300 - 125.325. The determination of whether an individual is acting in a parental relationship, for purposes of determining residency, depends on the evaluation of the factors listed in ORS 419B.373. The determination for other purposes depends on evaluation of those factors and a power of attorney executed pursuant to ORS 109.056. For special education students, parent also includes a surrogate parent, an adult student to whom rights have transferred and foster parent as defined in OAR 581-015-0005 (18).
