Public Conduct on District Property

No person on district property will:

1. Injure or threaten to injure another;
2. Damage the property of another or of the district;
3. Violate parking regulations;
4. Drive a vehicle in an unsafe manner;
5. Impede, delay or otherwise interfere with the orderly conduct of the district's educational program or any other activity taking place on district property which has been authorized by the Board, superintendent, principal or other authorized administrator;
6. Enter any portion of district premises at any time for purposes other than those which are lawful and authorized by district officials;
7. Possess an unauthorized loaded or unloaded firearm or any other instrument used as a dangerous or deadly weapon as defined in law and Board policy;
8. Consume, sell, give or deliver unlawful drugs including drug paraphernalia and alcoholic beverages;
9. Smoke or use tobacco products;
10. Wear, possess, use, distribute, display or sell any clothing, jewelry, emblem, badge, symbol, sign or other things which are evidence of membership or affiliation in any gang. Use speech or commit any act or omission in furtherance of the interests of any gang or gang activity. A "gang" is defined as a group that identifies itself through the use of a name, unique appearance or language including hand signs, claiming of geographical territory or the espousing of a distinctive belief system that frequently results in criminal activity;
11. Drive or park unauthorized motor vehicles, except on a regularly designated driveway or parking lot, on any school grounds within the district. Notices will be posted stating the school's usage restrictions at each school, and the district will cooperate with the appropriate police departments toward enforcement of this policy. Individual school building administrators may establish further rules to control vehicles on school property;

12. Ride a horse on school property at any time;
13. Willfully violate other district rules and regulations designed to maintain public order on school property.

Persons having no legitimate purpose or business on district property or violating or threatening to violate the above rules may be issued a trespass citation and/or referred to law enforcement officials.
