Prohibited Use, Distribution or Sale of Tobacco Products and Inhalant Delivery Systems on District Premises by Public

Use of tobacco or inhalant delivery systems on district premises is prohibited.

For the purpose of this policy “tobacco products” is defined to include, but not limited to, any lighted or unlighted cigarette, cigar, pipe, clove cigarette, and any other smoking product, spit tobacco, also known as smokeless, dip, chew, or snuff, in any form. This does not include products that are USFDA approved for sale as a tobacco cessation product or for any other therapeutic purpose if marketed and sold solely for the approved purpose.

For the purpose of this policy, “inhalant delivery system” means a device that can be used to deliver nicotine or cannabinoids in the form of a vapor or aerosol to a person inhaling from the device; or a component of a device or a substance in any form sold for the purpose of being vaporized or aerosolized by a device, whether the component or substance is sold or not sold separately. This does not include products that are USFDA-approved for sale as a tobacco cessation product or for any other therapeutic purpose, if marketed and sold solely for the approved purpose.

Violation of this policy by the public may result in the individual’s removal from district property. The district reserves the right to restrict access to district property by individuals who are repeat offenders.
