Advisory Committees to the Board

The Board may appoint such advisory committees as it deems necessary.

Advisory committees may consist of citizens, teachers, administrators, other employees and Board members. The number and composition of the committee will be determined by the circumstance and Board direction at the time the committee is established.

A Board appointed committee may meet in any of the district's facilities by arrangement with the building administrator. Materials, postage and copy equipment will be supplied by the district upon request.

The purpose of the committee and any specific goals will be established by the Board at the time of the committee appointment.

All meetings of advisory committees shall follow all public meeting laws. The press may attend and report proceedings. Visitors shall sit apart from the committee members and shall speak only when invited to do so by the committee chair.

The Board may appoint special committees of citizens and others to assist in developing school planning. The Board is to establish the duties and limitations of all such committees.
