## Safety Program

Safety for students and staff is of primary importance to the district. A regular program of safety checks will be administered in all buildings.

Buildings will be provided with alarm systems, fire extinguishers and other devices as required by state and federal laws and regulations.

In each school location, the site council shall be responsible for developing and maintaining a comprehensive safety program for all employees and students in the building. The site council will consult with the maintenance supervisor and superintendent regarding safety surveys and safety procedures.

Accident prevention instruction will be given students and staff, and safety procedures will be taught.

The district will develop and maintain specific procedures and plans related to injury, accident and safety reporting or prevention.
