Facilities Development Goals

Provision of the best possible facilities for students is the goal of the Board. There are certain constraints which must be considered when providing for facilities and their operation. Included in, but not necessarily limited to, these constraints are:

1. Safety must be a prime consideration when providing and operating facilities. The superintendent shall provide a comprehensive safety plan which will have consideration for all students, employees and patrons of the district;
2. Laws and/or regulations at the federal, state and local level must be followed when planning for new facilities or in the operation of existing facilities;
3. Budgetary limitations are a necessary constraint in the consideration for facilities;
4. As elected representatives of the people of the district, the Board must consider the desire of the people in this district when planning for facilities or in the operation of existing facilities.
