## Mother Friendly Workplace

The district recognizes that a normal and important role for mothers is to have the option and ability to provide for expressing milk in the workplace. The Board directs the superintendent or designee to take measures and develop regulations to ensure that all district employees shall be provided with an adequate location for the expression of milk.

The superintendent or designee shall see that the district makes a reasonable effort to provide a room or other location, other than a restroom, where an employee can express milk in privacy. This policy directs the superintendent or designee to include the following in the development of a regulation to ensure the provisions for employees required by this policy:

1. The advice of a school nurse or health professional in determining the most reasonable facility accommodation;
2. The plan shall include an accessible, private room with a lock that would allow a mother to pump breast milk to be stored for later use.
3. The room shall include:
  - a. Electrical outlets for electric pumps;
  - b. Sanitation facilities including a sink close by, for hand washing and the rinsing of containers; and
  - c. A sign up sheet and a sign posting the room as “private during use.”

A reasonable effort will be made to provide a flexible work schedule in consideration of the requirements of the staff member’s responsibility.
