Talented and Gifted Program

The district is committed to an educational plan that recognizes, identifies and serves the unique needs of talented and gifted students. Talented and gifted students are those who have been identified as academically talented and/or intellectually gifted.

The Board directs the superintendent, in consultation with the district staff, to develop a written identification process for identifying academically talented and intellectually gifted students K-12.

A written plan that identifies programs or services needed to address the assessed levels of learning and accelerated rates of learning of identified students shall be similarly developed. Identified students shall be served from special programs and planning that has been derived from the regular academic instructional program. All required written course statements shall identify the academic instructional programs and services which shall be provided.

The district may also identify and provide programs for students who demonstrate creative abilities, leadership abilities or unusual abilities in visual or performing arts.
