

Homebound Instruction

Prior to approving an application for home instruction, the parent or guardian shall provide to district officials:

1. A physician's statement by a pediatrician or other physician licensed by a state board of medical examiners, verifying the fact that the student is unable to attend school, yet able to receive home instruction services.

The purpose of this examination is to determine whether there is/are any medical factor(s) contributing to the student's educational problem(s) and whether treatment is needed prior to the offering of home instruction services.
