Field Trips and Special Events**

The Board believes that it is the responsibility of the district to provide students with an educational environment in which an individual can attain maximum growth in the development of abilities. The Board also believes that the district sometimes should transport students beyond the four walls of the classroom to provide experiences to enhance school programs as well as provide opportunities not available in the classroom. These opportunities should be judged on their contribution to the education of students and must be well planned in advance.

The Board recognizes that by encouraging instructional activities beyond the school premises, various factors such as safety, financing, insurance and student supervision become more complex. These factors must therefore be weighed against the potential educational outcomes.

To assure that district-sponsored travel for students is carefully planned, administrative rules as established by the district must be followed. The superintendent is charged with the responsibility of implementing administrative rules as may be needed.
