

Credit Reduction/Credit Denial

As a result of poor attendance, a student's grade may be reduced and/or credit denied only in accordance with the following:

1. The teacher will identify how the attendance and class participation is related to the instructional goals of the subject or course;
2. Parents and students will be informed;
3. Procedures in due process are available to the student when the grade is reduced or credit denied;
4. Reasons for non-attendance are considered and the grade is not reduced or credit denied based upon absences due to:
 - a. Religious reasons;
 - b. A student's disability; or
 - c. An excused absence, as determined by the district's policy.
