

### **Remote Rural Schools Enrollment**

1. Student and legal guardian lives in the designated enrollment area (defined below).
2. Student was enrolled at rural school for more than half of the concurrent school year.
3. Sibling is currently enrolled as a rural school student.
4. Student enrolled in a non-5J program or has been enrolled for more than half of the previous school year with evidence program is not serving student's educational needs.<sup>1</sup>
5. Student has educational needs for which rural school is least restrictive/best fit environment.<sup>1</sup>
6. Student/family has special circumstances for which rural school provides best fit.<sup>1</sup>
7. Other openings by random draw, as space allows.
  - a. Enrollment decisions regarding students in categories 2-7 will be made by the administrator on a year-by-year basis, as space allows.
  - b. See Board Policy IHB for class size: Pre-K, Kg - Gr. 2, Gr. 3-6.
  - c. Enrollment decisions made by administrative staff are final. See Board Policy KL for district complaint procedure.
  - d. Availability of district transportation to rural schools from outside the rural schools enrollment area is subject to annual review based on availability of staffing and fiscal resources.

#### **Boundary Description for Haines**

1. Everything west of Hwy 30 from Wingville to Maxwell Lane/ Haines cemetery
2. Wingville to Pine Creek Loop
3. All homes north of Pine Creek to intersection of Foothill Road and Anthony Lakes Hwy

#### **Boundary Description for Keating**

1. Medical Springs/Keating area

#### **Other:**

1. Rural Schools allowed to absorb overflow students from Baker area schools as needed, up to the class size maximums, less 2 students.
