## **Expulsion\*\***

Expulsion is the termination of the student's rights to attend school and school activities for a substantial period of time. Expulsion of a student shall not extend beyond one calendar year.

The student may be suspended by the principal pending possible expulsion to protect the welfare of the students and staff and/or to protect district property.

Student expulsion proceedings will be carried out in private hearings by the superintendent or his/her designated authority unless the student, parent or guardian requests a public hearing. The student's name, the issue and the discussion will not be made public unless the hearing is public.

When serious discipline of a student (expulsion or suspension for more than ten school days) is contemplated, the student shall be permitted to have a hearing as described in administrative rules unless the student, parent or guardian waives this right.

The district will not accept a student who has been expelled from another school district during the term of the expulsion.
