Conduct of Board Meetings

The rules of parliamentary procedure contained in *Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised*, will govern the Board in its deliberations. Discussion by Board members will be unlimited so long as it applies to the motion before the Board or the matter under consideration. The Board may vote to limit discussion and the chair will confine discussion to the matter before the Board. The chair may limit the time of any citizen appearing before the Board in order that all who wish to be heard may have the opportunity.

Individual votes on motions and/or resolutions will be "yes" or "no", and the result of the vote of each member will be recorded by name. A Board member who abstains from voting will be so recorded.
