## Board Goals

The Board's primary responsibilities are to establish purposes, programs, policies and procedures to best produce the educational achievement needed by district students. The Board is also responsible for effective management of resources available to the district. The Board fulfills these responsibilities by adopting policies, by oversight of effective implementation of those policies and by evaluating the results.

In accordance with these principles, the Board, through its operations, will seek to achieve the following goals:

1. Maintain effective communication with the students, staff and the public to maintain awareness of attitudes, opinions, desires and ideas;
2. Conduct Board business openly, soliciting and encouraging broad-based involvement of the students, staff and the public in the Board's decision-making processes;
3. Develop a plan to address and fund the school deferred maintenance priorities;
4. Develop a vision and plan for the 2011-2012 and 2012-2013 school years which addresses the charter school's student capacity and associated staff, facility and financial constraints;
5. Address the School Board's role in student achievement through participation in at least one workshop with student achievement focus.
