## First Aid\*\*

In cases of sudden illness or injury to a student or staff member, first aid will be given by school staff. Further medical attention to students is the parents' responsibility, or of someone the parents designate in case of emergency.

The principal is charged with providing for the immediate care of ill or injured persons within his/her area of responsibility.

Staff members shall report self-administered first-aid treatment to an immediate supervisor.

Procedures for handling health emergencies will be established and made known to the staff. The school and all school vehicles will be equipped with appropriate first-aid supplies and equipment. All employees are expected to know where first-aid supplies and equipment are kept in their work areas.

Designated employees in the building shall hold current first-aid cards. In compliance with Oregon Administrative Rules, the school shall have, at a minimum, at least one staff member with a current first-aid card for every 60 students enrolled or an emergency response team per building. Such team shall consist of no less than six persons who hold current first-aid/CPR cards and who are trained annually in the district and building emergency plans. Names of the designated employees will be posted.
