Promotion and Retention of Students K-8**

The Board is dedicated to total and continuous development of each student enrolled. The professional staff is expected to place students at the grade level best suited to them academically, socially and emotionally.

Students will normally progress annually from grade to grade (K-8). Exceptions may be made when, in the judgement of the professional staff, such exceptions are in the best educational interest of the students involved. Parents will be notified as soon as practicable if professional staff is considering retention. Exceptions will always be made after prior notification and explanation to the student's parents or legal guardians, but the final decision will rest with school authorities.

To better prepare students for high school, middle level students six through eight will be required to pass three of four basic subjects to be promoted to the next grade level. Those basic subjects are math, science, social studies and English.
