Homework

The term “homework” refers to an assignment to be prepared outside of class or during a period of supervised study in class. The purposes of homework are to improve the learning processes, to aid in the mastery of skills and to create and to stimulate interest on the part of the student.

Homework is a learning activity which should increase in complexity with the student’s maturity. Teachers should make meaningful assignments, the purposes of which should be clearly understood by both the teacher and the student.

Well-designed homework assignments relate directly to class work and extend students’ learning beyond the classroom. Homework is most useful when teachers carefully prepare the assignment, thoroughly explain it and give prompt comments and criticism when the work is completed.
