**Admissions**

All persons seeking admission to the district must satisfactorily meet all residency, academic, age, immunization, tuition and other eligibility prerequisites for admission as set forth in state and federal law, Board policy and administrative regulations. All candidates for admission will be informed of admission requirements.

At the time of enrollment, the parent will present to the principal a certifying document that proves birthdate, such as birth certificate, baptismal certificate or other valid indicator of birthdate and place for all first year entrants to school.

Students entering from other Oregon public schools into the district shall be accepted as having presented valid evidence of proof of birth at the prior enrolling school.

Students entering from outside Oregon into district schools will be asked to verify birthdate as a condition of entering.

Students under the age of sixteen will be admitted upon parental request regardless of prior attendance unless expelled for a weapons policy violation from another district before applying to Brookings-Harbor High School. Admission following excessive absence may well result in failure to earn credit for coursework attempted. Continued attendance problems will activate routine disciplinary action.

Students located in the district shall not be excluded from admission solely because the student does not have a fixed place of residence or solely because the student is not under the supervision of a parent.

Students located in the district shall not be excluded from admission where they are otherwise eligible, and not yet attained the age of 19 prior to the beginning of the current school year.

The district may admit an otherwise eligible person who is not receiving special education and who has not yet attained 21 years of age prior to the beginning of the current school year if the person is shown to be in need of additional education in order to receive a diploma.
