

Student Conduct on Activity Trips

All district students on out-of-town excursions will abide by the following rules:

1. Students will conduct themselves at all times according to the standards of best behavior and remember that they are guests in another community;
2. Students will refrain from the **use of, distribution of, and contact** with all substances and items not lawful for them to possess. This shall include, but not be limited to, alcohol for consumption, tobacco and unprescribed drugs. It shall also include any item acquired by theft or any other unlawful means;
3. Any student who becomes aware of the presence of contraband items shall be expected to report such to a chaperone overseeing the excursion. Failure to do so will constitute willful contact and awareness, and will be subject to disciplinary action;
4. Any event or episode in violation of policy JFCCA will be dealt with as follows:
 - a. Students proven to be in possession of contraband (i.e., alcohol, drugs, stolen property, etc.) will be declared ineligible for any and all activities for the remainder of the athletic season in which the offense occurs and all concurrent seasons;
 - b. If proof is provided that such contraband was acquired during an excursion under the auspices of the district, the offending student will be suspended for three days and will be ineligible for activities for the remainder of the school year. A repeat offense will result in a recommendation for expulsion and extended ineligibility;
 - c. Students shown to be guilty of making contraband available to others will be recommended for expulsion and declared ineligible for future out-of-town activities;
 - d. Those guilty of distributing any item forbidden by law will be referred to law enforcement.

Students under the influence of drugs or alcohol or who are flagrantly disobedient **may be removed from the vehicle and turned over to local law enforcement authorities.** This shall be done only after contact with the administration. Administrators will then contact the parents of the student and advise them to make arrangements to pick up their student.
