Safety Program

The district shall maintain a comprehensive safety program for employees and students. All staff shall help maintain a safe and healthful environment.

Buildings, grounds, and equipment shall be maintained in order to prevent accidents or injury to students, employees, and other citizens. Buildings shall have safety plans to be equipped and maintained in accordance with appropriate local, state and federal safety regulations. Buildings shall also be provided with alarm systems, fire extinguishers, and such other devices required by state and federal laws and regulations.

The superintendent or his/her designee shall develop and implement safety programs which will include, but not limited to, compliance with and enforcement of all state and federal laws, rules and regulations.
