The district shall maintain a coordinated valid and reliable data-driven K-12 program designed to improve student achievement, support students' academic growth beyond proficiency in the knowledge and skills of the student's current grade level, encourage their attainment of individual goals and successfully prepare students to function effectively in a rapidly changing world and for the futures they choose to pursue.

The district will work with staff, parents and community members to develop district goals that support the physical and cognitive growth and development of students. Goals will be adopted by the Board consistent with the goals adopted by the State Board of Education. Goals will be reviewed at least annually and revised as needed. Goals will utilize valid and reliable data for evaluating the success of curriculum, instruction, resource allocation and school improvement.

The goal of the district, working in cooperation with staff, parents, and community members, is to provide a district that, through the following characteristics, supports the physical and cognitive growth and development of students:

District Academic Goals

1. Every child performs at grade level in reading, writing and math by the end of 3rd grade.
2. Every child leaves 8th grade academically ready for 9th grade.
3. Every student finishes 9th grade with credits necessary to graduate on time.
4. Every student graduates ready for college and/or career.
