Disposal of District Property

The superintendent may, at any time, declare district personal property as surplus and authorize its disposal when such property is no longer useful to the district, unsuitable for school use, too costly to repair or obsolete.

If reasonable attempts to dispose of surplus properties fail to produce a monetary return to the district, the superintendent may dispose of them in another manner.

If the district property was purchased with state, federal or private grant funds disposal of the property shall be made as outlined in the grant or by state or federal regulations.
