District Vehicles

District vehicles includes all district owned and/or contracted/leased school buses, delivery or maintenance vehicles.

District Vehicle Idling Times

1. When school bus drivers arrive at loading and unloading areas to drop off or pick up passengers, they will turn off their buses as soon as possible to eliminate idling time and reduce harmful emissions.
2. The school bus should not be restarted until it is ready to depart and there is a clear path to exit the pick up/drop off area.
3. School buses will not idle (on school grounds or off school grounds) for longer than five minutes unless:
 - a. They are waiting in traffic;
 - b. They are loading/unloading students with special needs;
 - c. There are safety or emergency situations;
 - d. There are maintenance or mechanical inspections or repair; or
 - e. There are extreme weather conditions (temperatures of less than 40 degrees Fahrenheit) and the purpose is to warm the interior of the bus.
4. All district service or delivery vehicles shall turn off the engines after arriving to make deliveries to, or perform maintenance of, school buildings.

Notification

A copy of this administrative regulation shall be posted in a prominent place in appropriate district facilities so that all transportation, delivery and maintenance staff can view them with ease.
