Talented and Gifted Program

The district is committed to an educational program that recognizes, identifies and serves the unique needs of talented and gifted students. Talented and gifted students are those who have been identified as academically talented and/or intellectually gifted.

The Board directs the staff to develop procedures for identifying academically talented, intellectually gifted and other students possessing special talents and capabilities K-12.

The Board further directs the superintendent to develop a written plan that identifies programs or services needed to address the assessed levels of learning and accelerated rates of learning of identified students. All required written course statements shall identify the academic instructional programs and services which shall be provided.

Other students who demonstrate the potential to perform at the eligibility criteria, as well as, additional students who are talented and gifted, may be identified.
