Temporary District Facilities

Because rented facilities, relocatable units and other emergency school housing may be inadequate for long-term public school purpose, it is the Board's aim to have sufficient permanent facilities to meet the needs of school enrollment and the school program.

If circumstances require immediate space not available in public school buildings, facilities will be rented or relocatable structures used only as a temporary measure. Any such facility must conform to all appropriate state and local building and land use codes, health and fire laws, environmental standards and provisions for accessibility and usability as required by the ADA.
