## Admission of Exchange Students

The district will accept a maximum of six exchange students from other nations in those exchange programs officially recognized by the Board and who are on a J-1 Visa. Exchange students on a J-1 Visa are not required to pay tuition.

Exchange programs recognized by the Board are:

1. Global World International;
2. Nacel Open Door;
3. AFS (formerly, the American Field Service);
4. EF (Education First);
5. Rotary;
6. 4-H;
7. AYUSA (Academic Year in the USA);
8. Youth for Understanding;
9. AIFS (American Institute for Foreign Study).

Other organizations may be considered upon their timely application for review by the Board. Application for permission to operate must be filed with the superintendent's office by May 1 of the year prior to enrollment.

Privately sponsored exchange students on an F-1 Visa may be enrolled if an adult resident of the district has been given temporary guardianship and the student lives in the home of the guardian. Exchange students on an F-1 Visa are required to pay tuition at the established district rate. F-1 student admission is limited to secondary schools and attendance may not exceed 12 months.

Exchange students must comply with immunization requirements set forth in state law. Once admitted, exchange students become subject to all district policies and regulations governing students.
