Early Entrance**

For a child to be admitted to kindergarten, a child must be five years of age on or before September 1. To be admitted to first grade, a child must be six years of age on or before September 1.

For all first year entrants to school, being either five or six years of age, the parent will present to the building principal, at the time of enrollment, a verifying document that proves birth date, such as: birth certificate, baptismal certificate or other valid indicators of birth date and place.

Students entering from other Oregon schools shall be accepted as having presented valid evidence of proof of birth at the prior enrolling school.

Requests for exceptions to the above shall be processed according to the following procedures:

1. The parents are to be informed that any child not meeting the requirements specified must be individually tested in the areas of cognitive, social and physical development to obtain data on which to base a decision;
2. If testing is to take place, the principal is to obtain written parental permission for the administration of an individual test. Copies of this written permission are to be filed in the district office;
3. Once testing has been completed, the results are to be discussed with the building principal, with the resulting tester-principal recommendations shared with the parent. Copies of the test results are to be filed in the district office;
4. Children enrolled under these procedures are to be admitted “conditionally” with this concept clearly communicated to the parent. Primarily, the child’s ability to cope with the demands of formal schooling will affect continued enrollment;
5. Once a child has attended for a period of four weeks, continued enrollment will not be challenged.
