

Community Use of College Facilities

Off-campus groups or organizations (profit or nonprofit) may sponsor programs using College facilities by following established Facilities Use Guidelines.

Students/staff and community members are encouraged to use facilities for a wide variety of purposes including but not limited to instruction, special events and programs, community recreation and meetings. When it is necessary to assess fees for facility use, the fees will include the costs directly associated with the event (set up, take down, increased security, cleaning and special equipment) as well as the indirect costs incurred by the College (utilities, scheduling costs, equipment, facility maintenance and repair).

Since the institution is supported by tax dollars, college events and nonprofit group events will be assessed fees that are lower than the fees charged to profit organizations and events. The College reserves the right to deny facility use for events that conflict or compete with the College mission or programs and events that are deemed to be a legal liability.
