Executive Sessions

The Board may go into executive session during a regular, special, or emergency meeting on the call of the presiding officer for purposes in compliance with ORS 192.660 and 332.061.

Those purposes may include:

1. To consider the employment of a public officer, staff member, or individual agent.
2. To consider the dismissal or disciplining of, or to hear complaints or charges brought against, a public officer, employee, staff member, or agent, unless he or she or the agent requests an open meeting.
3. To conduct deliberations with persons designated by the governing body to carry on labor negotiations. Labor negotiations between Board and union are held in open session unless both parties agree to executive sessions.
4. To conduct deliberations with persons designated by the governing body to negotiate real property transactions.
5. To consider records exempt by law from public inspection.
6. To consult counsel concerning the legal rights and duties of a public body with regard to current litigation or litigation likely to be filed.
7. To review and evaluate the performance of the chief executive officer or any public officer, employee, or staff member, unless the person whose performance is being reviewed and evaluated requests an open hearing.

8. To conduct a hearing on the expulsion of a student or review a student's confidential medical records.
