Corporal Punishment**

Corporal punishment is prohibited by Oregon law and is not an acceptable practice for discipline in any education program operated by CESD.

Definitions

1. Corporal punishment is any act which willfully inflicts or willfully causes the infliction of physical pain on a student.
2. Corporal punishment does not include any physical pain or discomfort resulting from or caused by a student's voluntary participation in an athletic competition or recreational activity, or physical exertion shared by all the students in a teacher directed calls activity, which may include, but is not limited to, physical education exercises, field trips, or vocational education projects.
3. Corporal punishment does not include the use of physical restraint or seclusion specified in a student's behavior support plan and/or consistent with Board policy JGAB-AR - Use of Restraint and Seclusion.
