

Use of Corporal Punishment with Students

1. The superintendent shall establish a procedure for annual distribution of the Board's policy prohibiting corporal punishment and directing that any staff person observing another employee or volunteer using corporal punishment, physical discipline, or physical abuse shall follow CESD's child abuse reporting procedure and report the incident to the program's supervisor.
2. The superintendent shall establish policy and procedures for the use of physical restraint or seclusion as an individually designed behavior intervention in a student's behavior support plan to be used only when less restrictive interventions would not be effective in a behavioral incident involving a threat of imminent serious physical harm to the student or others.
