Admissions

Silver Falls School District (district) residents shall have priority for admission into the Community Roots School (school) and shall be allowed to fill all enrollment slots available in their grade in the school. Students are considered district residents if they reside in Silver Falls School District by the application deadline of March 31 or can prove through documentation that they will be residing in Silver Falls School District by the first day of school.

Children selected for enrollment in the school must be at least six years of age by September 1 of the school year they will be enrolled in the school.

The school strives to reach all families in the district who would like a Montessori education for their children. The school will not limit student admission based on race, religion, marital status, socioeconomic status, familial status, sex, sexual orientation, ethnicity, national origins, disability, health, whether a student has an individual education program (IEP) or the terms of that IEP, identified as talented and gifted, income level, residence, proficiency in English, athletic ability or academic records. The school does not require payment of fees as a condition of admission to those students entitled under the law to free admission. Student or families are encouraged to participate in fund-raising activities.
