Infection Control - HIV, AIDS, Hepatitis B

The district shall use universally recognized precautions at all times for infection control. Each staff member or student is therefore treated as though an HIV, AIDS or HBV¹ infection exists.

The district shall develop an exposure control plan that includes infection control procedures for staff and students.

Procedures for staff and students shall include annual in-services; first-aid kits readily available in each school building and each school vehicle; correct procedures for cleaning up body fluid spills and for personal cleanup.

In addition to an annual in-service, staff and students on a regular basis will receive HIV, AIDS and HBV information.

The information shall emphasize infection — how infection is spread as well as how it is not spread.

The district will cooperate with the local health department in delivering HIV, AIDS and HBV education.
