Kindergarten Education

The district provides education for students in grades kindergarten through grade 12.

In order to anticipate the number of students to enroll in the kindergarten classes for the following year, the following procedure will be followed:

On or before January 30 of the preceding year, a formal invitation shall be given for parents to contact the school to inform the school that they have a student who meets the requirements of age and district residence. This shall be done through the school newsletter, and local newspapers.

The information requested from the parent shall include the following: student name, student birth date, parent name, address and phone number.

In April of the year of enrollment, a formal preregistration meeting shall be held for the incoming kindergarten students and their parents. The kindergarten teacher will be present to meet the students and parents as well as the superintendent and other invited officials. Information shall be given to the parents and formal registration information will be collected. The students will be taken to the kindergarten room and have time with the kindergarten teacher and kindergarten aide.
