

High School Scholastic Eligibility

It is the responsibility of the coach/advisor and activities director to insure that every member of his/her program is eligible in accordance with current Oregon School Activities Association (OSAA) regulations, the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) requirements, requirements of the student handbook and the district policies. The following eligibility requirements must be met:

1. A student must have a current grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.0 (C) at the grading period (mid-term and quarter);
2. A student must have passing grades in all classes;
3. If a student does not meet criteria set in section 1. above, but meets criteria set in 2., he/she will be placed on probation for one week. During probation, the student will be allowed to participate in activities while bringing up their grades. It is the responsibility of the activities director and/or principal to check on the eligibility status of each probationary student on Wednesday of the next week. If a probationary student does not meet the probationary standards, he/she will not be eligible to participate in activities, but must attend practices, if appropriate, and do his/her homework during practice as long as he/she is ineligible. The student remains ineligible until he/she is passing in all subjects;
4. Probationary and ineligible students' grades will be checked every Wednesday. Students appearing on the probation/ineligible list will be placed on immediate probation and will stay on the list until the following week. The 2.0 GPA requirement will be checked at the 4 1/2 week grading period.

Students will be notified by the teacher or principal and parents/guardians will be notified by the principal that students are on probation or ineligible.

1. Cross country;

6. Tennis;

7. Cheerleading;
8. Student council;
9. Nonacademic field trips
10. FBLA activities (if not class related);
11. FFA activities (if not class related);
12. Rodeo club;
13. National Honor Society (NHS);
14. Pep band;
15. Drama practice and productions;
16. Pep assemblies;
17. School parties and dances;
18. Other school activities.
