Extra-Curricular Activities Grades 5-12

All students must meet the minimum Oregon School Activities Association requirements, i.e. pass 5 classes in the previous semester. In addition, to participate in school based activities, students must maintain a “C” average grade at all times in classes. If a student falls below a “C” average in all classes in a weekly grade check he or she is ineligible to practice, perform or play games until the cumulative grade is brought up. The grades will be checked every Monday for the previous week. Staff will be notified by noon on Monday of students who are ineligible.

In any case of GPA calculation if a student has a grade of “F” in any class no matter whether the student has a 2.0 average or better, the student is ineligible until the “F” grade is improved to a “D” or higher and the student still has a weekly 2.0 GPA or higher.

The student remains on the ineligibility list until such time as the student’s grades are improved to a 2.0 or higher with no “F” grades. The ineligibility student cannot practice or play games until the deficient GPA is improved according to these guidelines.

All school based groups will be dressed and groomed appropriately as outlined by the coach/advisor in accordance with district policy and are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that will bring credit to the group and the community and the school as a whole.

Students will refrain from use, possession and/or distribution of illegal drugs, tobacco and alcohol, including any look alike or facsimile thereof, on or off campus and at any school related activity, home or away.

Violation of district alcohol, drug and/or tobacco policy shall result in discipline up to and including expulsion from school, and if involved in any school sponsored activity, suspension from that type of activity for a period of three months.

In addition, students who are elected to office, whether club, class or student body officers will lose their positions on the first occasion where the alcohol, tobacco and/or drugs policies are violated.
