Use of Feature Films or Videos in the School

The instructor's lesson plan must include the following before showing a film or video:

1. If appropriate (refer to Board policy IIABB – Use of Feature Films/Videos), parent consent in a written form;
2. Title and brief description;
3. Purpose for showing;
4. Match with curricular focus, course offering, and lesson objective; and
5. Audience rating.

Instructors are required to preview all films or videos before showing to students. A record of that viewing must be contained in the instructors lesson plan.

Parent notification for the showing of films or videos with a "PG" "PG-13" rating will be at the discretion of the administrator or individual instructor if the students are in or above grade nine. In addition, edited or non-rated films or videos will be shown at the discretion of the administrator or individual instructor after both or individually each has viewed the edited or non- rated film or video.

A record of the date and time of the viewing will be on record with the instructor. That record will be placed in the lesson plan of the individual instructor.

Academic freedom at the district is subject to tests of a "Limited Open Forum" as contained in the freedom of speech.
