Academic Achievement

The recognition of student academic achievement may include but not be limited to the following:

Grade School (K-5)

1. No fixed awards system.
2. Teacher presentations of stickers, buttons, etc., as determined by each teacher.

Middle School (6-8)

1. Honor roll, based on a GPA each quarter of 3.5 or higher.
2. Honorable mention, based on a GPA each quarter of 3.0 to 3.5.
3. Hall space utilized for posting the names of those on the Honor roll.
4. Names of students achieving honor roll and honorable mention status to be submitted to the local paper for publication.
5. A pin presented to students each time they are on the honor roll for two consecutive quarters.
6. A certificate presented to students who improve their GPA from one quarter to another:
 - a. One point or more;
 - b. One-half point to one point;
 - c. One-fourth point to one-half point.

High School (9-12)

1. Honor roll, based on a GPA each quarter of 3.5 or higher.
2. Honorable mention, based on a GPA each quarter of 3.0 to 3.5.
3. A "D" grade or a "NG" excludes a student from the honor roll/honorable mention even though he/she has a 3.0 to 3.5 average.
4. Hall space utilized for posting the names of those on the honor roll.

5. Names of students achieving honor roll and honorable mention status to be submitted to the local paper for publication.
6. Awards will be given as set or approved by student council.
