## Early Graduation\*\*

Increasingly diverse learning opportunities for high school students now make it possible for some students to complete graduation requirements in less than twelve years. A student who wishes to graduate from high school in less time than the ordinary grade 9-12 sequence may request permission to complete graduation requirements on an altered schedule. The student and his/her parents will consult with high school guidance personnel to develop a graduation plan. Their intention to accomplish this plan will be stated in writing to the superintendent.

“Early graduation” is defined to mean the completion of all graduation requirements for graduation in less than four years. The district will award a diploma to a student fulfilling graduation requirement in less than four years upon the student’s request and if the student’s parent or guardian consents, if required.

Students who have successfully completed the junior year with fewer than the required credits for graduation and are then accepted at accredited colleges may receive their high school diplomas if, at the completion of the first semester, they are in good scholastic standing at the college.

The superintendent will develop procedures for the implementation of early and delayed graduation progress for district students.
