Credit by Examination

Providing for individual differences among students results in a wide range of opportunities. Some students are capable of achieving the objectives of a particular course and thus being competent in that course without having to enroll or participate in the class.

Consequently, a credit by examination program will be established in the district. Credit by examination is a process for ascertaining student understanding of course material and awarding credit for a particular course, which is normally offered at the high school, without a student having to enroll or participate in the course.

When an examination has been designed and administered that assesses student understanding of course material and course objectives, then the student who successfully completes the examination shall receive credit for that course. Any requirement to enroll and pass the course will be waived. No distinction will be made between granting credit and waiving course requirements.

The superintendent will develop procedures for the implementation of credit by examination.
