## Admission of Foreign Exchange Students

In the interest of furthering better understanding and improving human relations among district students and youth from all parts of the world, the Board encourages the high school to participate in student foreign exchange programs.

Exchange students will be admitted to Condon High School in accordance with the requirements listed in administrative regulation JECBA-AR – Admission of Foreign Exchange Students and upon the approval of the superintendent.

Exchange students must meet all of the standards for admission to Condon High School including residency and immunization requirements. Once admitted, exchange students become subject to all policies and regulations governing the conduct and behavior of resident students. Exchange students will be expected to maintain passing grades in all subjects as well as a satisfactory attendance record.

Exchange students will be encouraged to participate in the full range of student activities including interscholastic athletics, provided they meet local and Oregon School Activities Association criteria.

Either an honorary or standard high school diploma may be awarded at regular commencement exercises to all foreign exchange students who successfully meet the necessary academic requirements during the year in which they attend. Exchange students shall not be included in any class ranking lists.

Privately sponsored exchange students on an F-1 Visa may only attend secondary schools within the district and are required to pay tuition at the established district rate. The period of attendance may not exceed 12 months.

Exchange students attending district schools on a J-1 Visa as part of a group-sponsored program are not required to pay tuition.

The Board reserves the right to limit the number of exchange students in a given year.
